Definitions

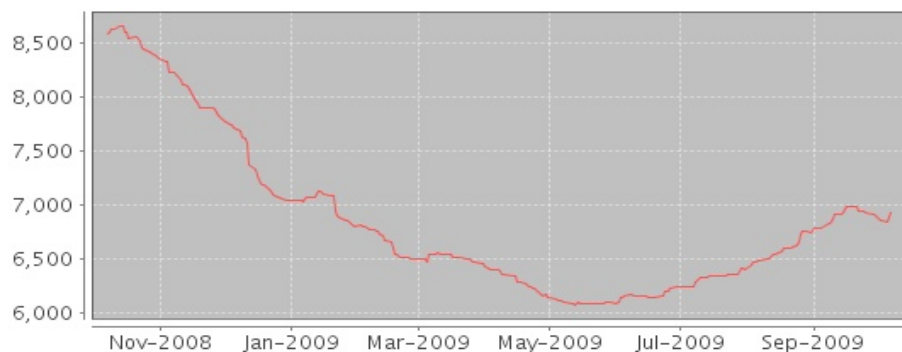
Column 1	Counter	- This is the short form of the name of the company whose security is listed

Column 9	Market Capitalisation	- This is the total value of the company that accrues to the holders / owners of the particular security.

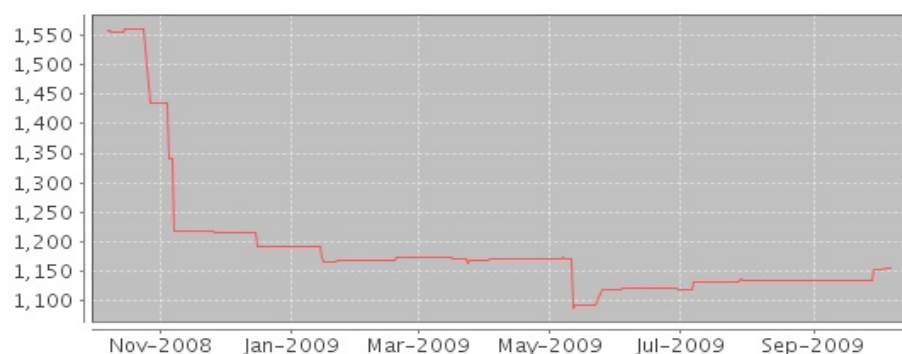

BOTSWANA GOVERNMENT LISTS BOND ON THE BSE (BW 006)

The Botswana Government listed an additional bond (BW 006) on the Botswana Stock Exchange on the 09th September 2009. BW 006 matures on the 09th of March 2012 with a fixed interest rate of 7.50%.

MESSINA COPPER (BOTSWANA) (PTY) LTD REDEEMS ITS FIXED RATE NOTES (ACU001)

Messina Copper (Botswana) (Proprietary) Limited has redeemed all its Fixed Rate Notes due 2 April 2015 (â€œACU 001 Notesâ€•) on the 21st August 2009.

EXTENSION OF SUSPENSION

DiamonEx Limited has requested a further suspension to trading of its shares on the Botswana Stock Exchange. The Judicial Management Order which has been granted to DiamonEx Botswana Limited remains in place following Court hearing regarding the order which took place on 27th February 2009. The DiamonEx shares shall remain suspended from trading until the Board of DiamonEx has confirmed its plans for the company.

BOTSWANA BUILDING SOCIETY(BBS) LISTS AN ADDITIONAL NOTE ON THE BSE.

Botswana Building Society listed its third tranche of BBS005 Fixed Rate Notes raising P150 Million from the P500 Million Note Programme approved by the BSE in July 2004. The Notes were listed on the 21st January 2009. The Fixed Rate Notes were issued by way of private placement and attract a fixed annual interest rate of 11.20% until maturity. The Notes mature on the 3rd December 2023.
